Situated in the heart of Busselton and attracting an average of 9,000 visitors each week, the market offers a dynamic location to establish an interactive gallery space in the region.

Perfect for artists with an existing suite of works ready to show in an Open Studio environment, the 'Artist in Residence' program offers the opportunity to display works in a personal exhibitionstyle. The dynamic workshop space lends itself to live displays, artist talks, workshops, and ongoing audience development. For creatives looking to further their retail presence, the Artisan Alley cooperative offers a unique option for artists and artisans to work together to showcase the region's finest works in one dynamic and supportive space, whilst sharing staffing and resourcing demands.

SPACE	Dynamic spaces for every need, from 2 sqm to 40 sqm.
MARKET LOCATION	Based near Artisan Alley with an opportunity for the artisan collective to support cash sales through their POS system when artists are not on site.
TYPE OF ARTIST	Painter, Sculptor, Photographer, Graphic Designer, Illustrator, Textile Artist, Ceramicist, Cinematographer.
TRADE	'In Residence' stall is manned by the group of artists as a cooperative arrangement. Installation is staffed Thursday to Sunday by Artists in Residence; working on site as well as promoting other artists' works when in residence.
MARKET ACTIVATION	Events, workshops and use of demonstration stage is encouraged.



VISITATION & MARKETING

Marketing campaigns, partnerships, sponsorships of regional events including Margaret River Region Open Studios and CinefestOZ, as well as a calendar of in house events and activations are designed to attract intrastate, interstate and international visitors. Visitation has increased steadily since opening in November 2021, with an average of 9,000 visitors per week. VISITOR FACILITIES

The market provides and maintains the following facilities on your behalf: parking, toilets, parenting room, plants, accessible toilets, rubbish collection and recycling, communal seating and tables and an indoor playground.

We also have a team of cleaners who maintain the building to pristine standards. All the above is provided at no cost to you.

SET UP

Whilst vendors are responsible for the cost of their fit out, the team at Origins Market will work with you to establish your stall/installation. This includes guidance on design and fit out, signage, sourcing contractors and point of sale set up. The fit out can be done to suit your budget and length of lease. Our affordable lease options will help catapult your art into a sustainable business and the workshop space provides means for an additional income stream through hosting events, for example 'Sip and Paint'.



COST ESTIMATES
